servant

Someone whose job is to work for someone else.

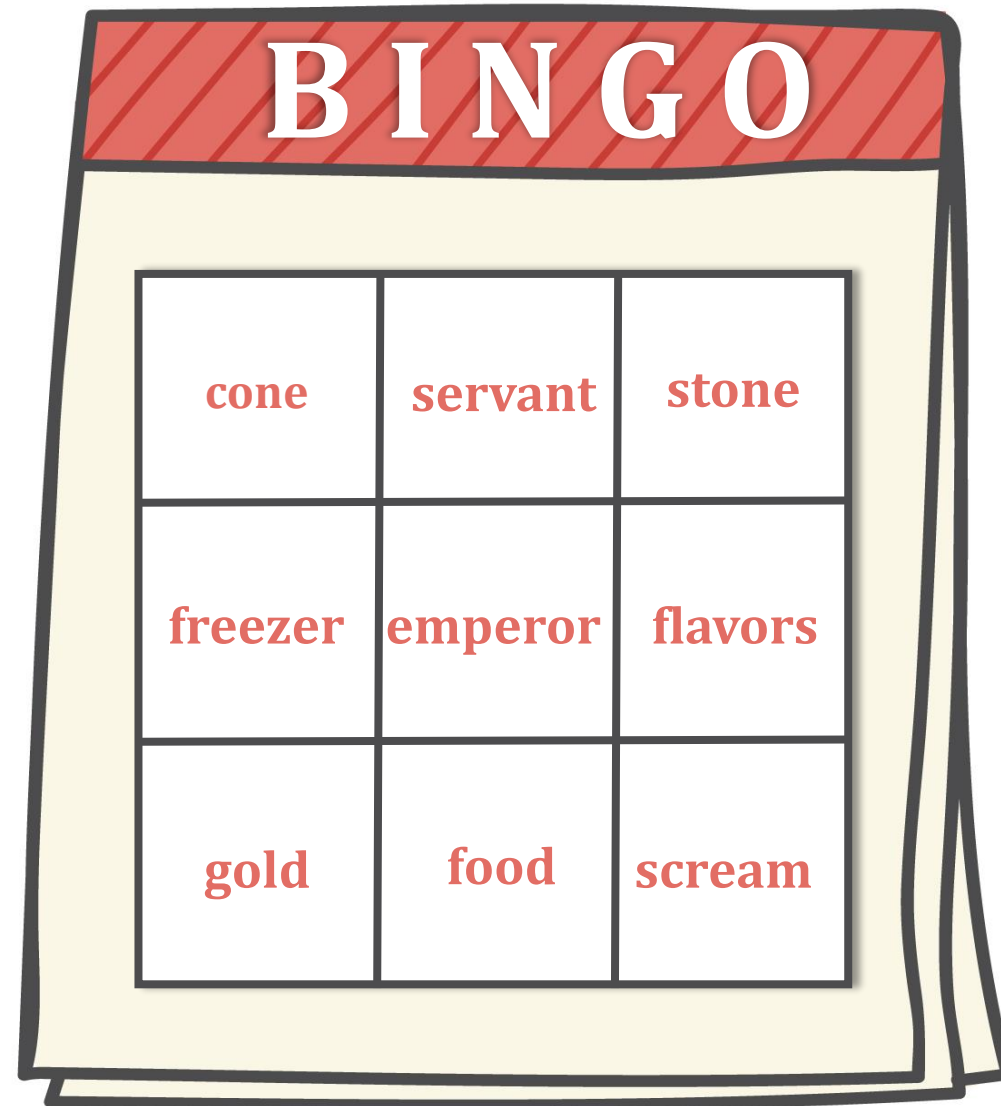
