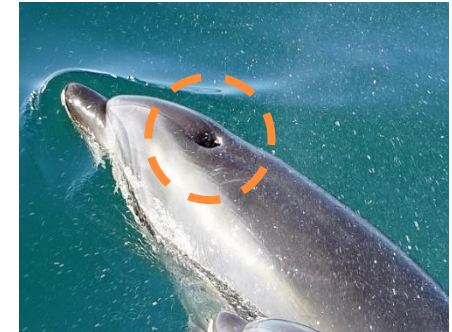

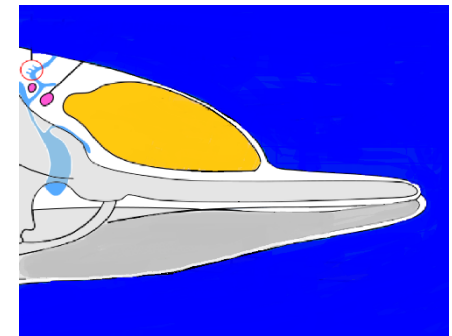
Why do Dolphins Whistle?

Scientists say that dolphins are intelligent. They are one of the world's smartest animals. In fact, they are considered as the second smartest creature next to humans.

Like people, dolphins also **communicate** with each other. However, they use their **blowholes** and **melons** to do it. Instead of saying words, they **whistle** to call other dolphins. These whistles serve as their names. So, each whistle is different from the other.

Dolphins also whistle to give directions. When a **calf** is lost, a mother dolphin whistles to call its calf. The other dolphins can still hear it **even if** it is far away. Dolphins have a sharp listening **ability** which is seven times better than humans. It makes them find food easily too even in a storm.

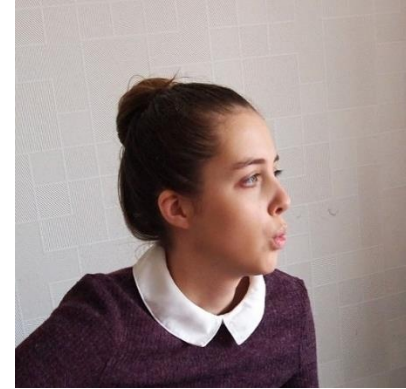
