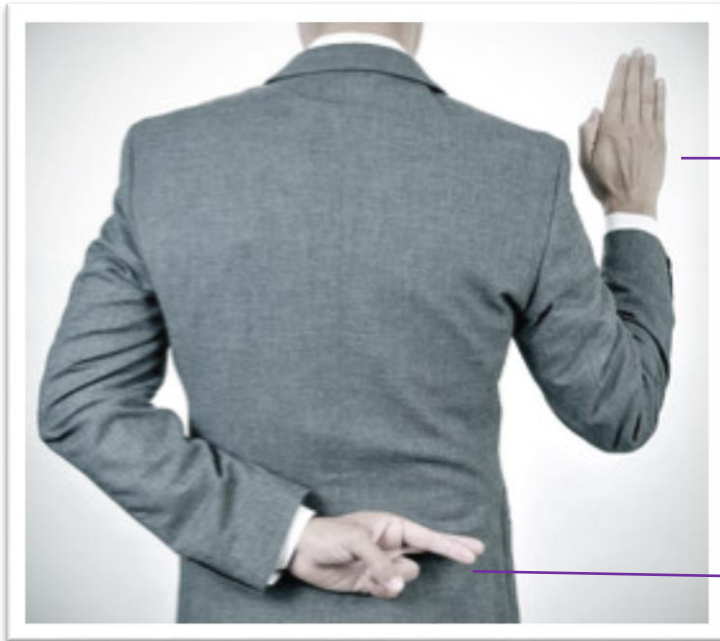

Can You Spot a Liar?

All of us lie from time to time -- **either** to get out of an uncomfortable situation or to **spare someone's feelings**. But there are people who lie all the time even about simple things. You may not see their noses shrink, but these **signs** can tell you when someone is lying.

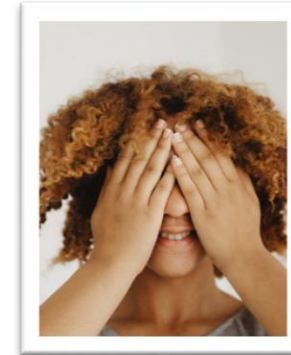
When you **spare someone's feelings**, you avoid doing or saying something that will hurt someone emotionally.

- **Read and learn**

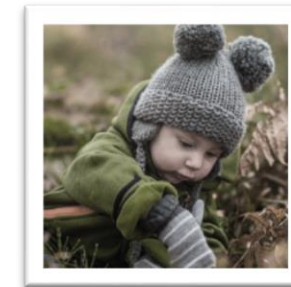

What's more, these people become **nervous** when they have to speak the truth. Experts investigated that liars develop this habit from **childhood**. So, if you think someone lies continuously, the best thing to do is observe them.
